Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On December 10, 2010, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 72035 in this docket.
2. Decision No. 72035 authorized Casa Grande West Water Company, Inc. ("Casa Grande" or "Company") to incur Water Infrastructure Financing Authority ("WIFA") debt for the purpose of financing arsenic treatment facilities and 100,000 gallons of additional storage capacity.
3. Decision No. 72035 ordered Casa Grande to file, by March 31, 2011, an Arizona Department of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") Approval of Construction ("AOC") for the arsenic treatment facilities, and to file, by December 31, 2011, an ADEQ AOC for 100,000 gallons of additional storage capacity.

1 4. Decision No. 72035 authorized the Company to file an application for approval of an
2 arsenic remediation surcharge after it secured the WIFA financing.

3 5. On September 29, 2011, as authorized by Decision No. 72035, Casa Grande filed a
4 request to implement an arsenic remediation surcharge.

5 6. On December 9, 2011, the Commission issued Decision No. 72717 in these dockets
6 authorizing implementation of the arsenic remediation surcharge. Decision No. 72717 ordered the
7 Company to file a tariff in conformance with the approved surcharge, and to notify its customers of
8 the surcharge.

9 7. On December 19, 2011, Casa Grande filed a letter requesting an extension of time of
10 one year to file the AOC for the additional storage capacity. In the letter, Casa Grande states that
11 while it has been planning the additional storage facilities, it has not yet completed construction of
12 the additional storage capacity because it has been devoting its personnel to operating the Company
13 and completing the arsenic treatment facilities in order to provide safe drinking water to its
14 customers.

15 8. On December 30, 2011, Casa Grande filed an Arsenic Surcharge Tariff as ordered by
16 Decision No. 72717.

17 9. Also December 30, 2011, Casa Grande filed a Notice of Surcharge that was mailed to
18 its customers on December 27, 2011, in compliance with Decision No. 72717.

19 10. Also on December 30, 2011, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a
20 response to Casa Grande's extension of time request. Staff states that it does not object to a one year
21 extension of time for the filing of the AOC demonstrating completion of the additional storage
22 capacity.

23 11. It is reasonable to extend the deadline for the filing of the AOC demonstrating
24 completion of the additional 100,000 gallons of storage capacity to December 31, 2012.

25 12. It is reasonable to put the Company on notice that any future requests for extensions of
26 time to comply with Decision No. 72035 must demonstrate the existence of extraordinary
27 circumstances that warrant additional time.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Casa Grande is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-250, 40-251, 40-301, 40-302, and 40-303.

2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Casa Grande, and the subject matter of this proceeding, including Casa Grande’s request for an extension of time to comply with Commission Decision No. 72035.

3. Under the circumstances, it is reasonable and in the public interest to grant Casa Grande’s request for a time extension to file the AOC demonstrating construction of the additional storage facilities.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the compliance deadline set by Decision No. 72035 for Casa Grande West Water Company, Inc. to file an Arizona Department of Environmental Quality Approval of Construction demonstrating construction of 100,000 gallons of additional storage capacity is hereby extended to December 31, 2012.

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
1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED no additional extensions of time will be granted regarding this
