On February 22nd I spoke with Arizona Public Service, and the Smart Meters will be removed from the Canyon Run property; however, APS did not provide me with a date for completion. This decision may be reversed in the future in the event additional cost is incurred as a result of this change.

We encourage you to continue contacting APS and the Arizona Corporation Commission with your concerns, as those agencies will ultimately be responsible for the decision; we have not yet taken a position as to the health issues involved, and our focus is solely on the economics.

Until the costs (if any) are established, we cannot provide you with any further information on our position and plan. We hope this response provides you with at least some peace of mind for the present.
