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

**PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE HEARING ON THE APPLICATIONS OF  
DELLS WATER COMPANY, INC. AND WILHOIT WATER COMPANY, INC. FOR  
APPROVAL FOR THE SALE OF THEIR ASSETS AND TRANSFER  
OF THEIR CERTIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY  
TO ACME WATER COMPANY, LLC.

On June 16, 2011, Dells Water Company, Inc. ("DWC") AND Wilhoit Water Company, Inc. ("WWC") (collectively "the Utilities"), each filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") applications for approval of the sale of their assets and transfer of their Certificates of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to ACME WATER COMPANY ("ACME"). If the applications are approved and the sale consummated, ACME would be the exclusive provide of domestic water service in DWC's and WWC's current service area. The Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") has recommended approval of the Utilities' applications. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by the Utilities, Staff, or any intervenors. The Commission will issue a Decision regarding the Utilities' applications following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. A copy of the applications are available at DWC's and WWC's offices, 907 N. Main Street, Clarkdale, Arizona and at the Commission offices at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix Arizona, public inspection during regular business hours, and on the internet via the Commission website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov).) using the e-docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on the applications on **April 9, 2012, at 10:00 a.m.** at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Hearing Room No. 2, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via e-mail (visit <http://www.azcc.gov/Divisions/Utilities/forms/PublicCommentForm.pdf> for instructions), or by mailing a letter referencing Docket Nos. W-01384A-11-0243, W-20809A-11-0243, W-02065A-11-0246 AND W-20809A-11-0246 to Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 or 602-542-4251.

The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you wish to intervene, you must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than **March 23, 2012**, and send a copy of the motion to DWC and WWC or their counsel and to all parties of record. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address, and telephone number of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself;
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g. a customer of DWC or WWC, etc.);
3. A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to DWC and WWC or their counsel and to all parties of record in the case; and
4. If you are not represented by an attorney who is an active member of the Arizona State Bar, and are not representing yourself as an individual, information and any appropriate documentation demonstrating compliance with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31,38, and 42, as applicable.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before March 23, 2012. If representation by counsel is required by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 31, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenors obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. For information about requesting intervention, visit the Commission's website at <http://www.azcc.gov/divisions/utilities/forms/intervene.pdf>. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the e application or from filing written comments in the record of the case.

The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
