Dear Commissioners:

I am so extremely electrically sensitive that I was forced to move away from the Phoenix area to an extremely rural area near Snowflake, Arizona in order to avoid electromagnetic frequency (emf) exposures. **I become severely ill when exposed to cell phones, cell towers, microwave towers, AM radio towers, broadband, wi-fi, motors, fans, and other signals.** This area is the only place I could find in the state to locate where I would not be subjected to those types of signals.

Late in 2010 a **Smart Meter was placed on my property** at 121 County Road 9234, Snowflake, AZ 85937. After the placement of the meter I became very ill. I suffered many medical symptoms and lost the use of my home and land. APS removed the meter. Due to my severe disability I am not able to relocate, stay in a motel or even live with a relative. During the week I had the meter I was forced to live in my truck during freezing temperatures.

There are thousands in the State with this medical condition and an entire community of electrically sensitive people living in this area.

For this reason, **I plead that you establish an opt-out program (which allows a non-electronic analog meter and no smart meter on their property)** and other measures that would protect disabled/electrically sensitive customers of APS. This disability is described in the three documents filed to Docket #E-00000C-11-0328 by the Safer Utilities Network on September 20 and October 31, 2001. APS claims the meters are safe as a cell phone, but like myself, many of us do not tolerate cell phone exposure without health consequences.

Reducing the amount of time that the Smart Meters are active will be of benefit to healthy individuals, but will not be enough for those who are severely sensitive.

Every Smart Meter has 2 signals being emitted. One is the signal that sends the meter reading. This signal is the one APS suggests could be limited to being off some of the time.


The second signal emitted by the Smart Meter is one that tells APS that the meter is on and working properly. This signal is sent out **every 10 seconds** or so. This is used to track power outages and could not be limited as the meter reading signal would be.

Thirdly, in order to power the digital type meter, a **step down converter** is used which produces a harmful emf signal. This emf emission would be continuous and and never turned off.

If a medical opt out plan (which allows a non-electronic analog meter) is not made available to me then I will be forced to go on a **solar system** which might cost me more than **\$30,000**. I am disabled. How will I pay for that?

Please consider the plight of those who will be made homeless due to the placement of a smart meter on their property.
