

Dear Mr. Pierce and Mr. Brokaw,

I'm writing in regards to the pending Commission Review of the Hartgraves/Morgan Financial Violations. (DOCKET NO: S-20719A-09-0583) Per Mr. Huynh's request I have made contact with Mr. Brokaw and currently I am gathering the information necessary to give a complete picture and thorough statement regarding Mr. Hartgraves' past and present involvement in Violating Arizona State Securities Law. I feel it is imperative that you have this information prior to making a decision on the current case at hand. The amount of data is voluminous and is taking me much longer than I anticipated.

I know this is last minute for your proceeding, but from my conversation with Mr. Huynh I left with an impression that my evidence may not have much bearing in your current issues and that the information would be used for an additional investigation. I cordially ask that you please allow me until March 29, 2012 to furnish you the evidence which I believe will explain all the details regarding the Violations of Law discussed. I believe this will enhance your ability to make a sound decision without hesitation.

Please let me know if you can grant me the short extension of time needed? I do not have Mr. Huynh's email to include him in this request so if you could please forward a copy of this email to him I would greatly appreciate it
