In his February 24, 2012 filing to Docket No. E-00000C-11-0328, Mr. Steven M. Olea stated that "Based on the comments and discussion received at the upcoming workshop meeting, Staff may develop an opt-out proposal for consideration by the Commission". With that possibility in mind, we wish to emphasize three documents in particular which were filed to the above-cited docket on September 20 and October 31, 2011 by Safer Utilities Network.

The residents of Snowflake's EHS sanctuary seek reasonable accommodation for our disability. We have proposed what we believe is a moderate and feasible opt-out program that will safeguard our homes and health. Given that we represent a tiny segment of APS' customer base, APS will still enjoy the tangible and intangible benefits of their AMI program.

Our situation is not hypothetical; our community's ability to survive is at issue. We thank the Commissioners for considering this weighty matter.


