The Links at Coyote Wash Utilities, L.L.C. (the "Company") hereby submits this Notice of Compliance pursuant to Decision No. 69209 (December 21, 2006) ("Order").

The Order requires that the Company, on an annual basis, for five years, file certification from the Arizona Department of Occupational Safety and Health ("ADOSH") that the Company has utilized ADOSH consultation services. Attached as **Exhibit 1** is a confirmation letter from Babak Emami, CET Supervisor of the Phoenix ADOSH Office, regarding the onsite consultation performed on December 8, 2011.

The Order also requires that the Company's operators, agents, and employees take appropriate training required by ADOSH. Currently, the Company is not subject to any specific training recommendation. However, the Company's operators are certified through the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality, and have attended various ADOSH training sessions in confined space entry. See the Company's Supplemental Notice of Compliance, filed February 3, 2010.

This is the Company's fifth and final ADOSH related compliance filing.
