Dear Chairman Pierce and Commissioners:

I have followed the deconsolidation proceedings before the AZ Corporation Commission and as a consumer and a ratepayer, I do not like paying for services not rendered. The deconsolidation issue for Anthem's wastewater is a case in point to the tune of \$2.4 mil (estimated). However, the Recommended Opinion and Order (ROO) is just and reasonable for the following reasons:

**Cost of Service:** Anthem's \$2.4 mil subsidization of Agua Fria is an estimate and not an actual. While not disputed during the hearings, if one is going to pay less (Anthem) or more (Agua Fria), it should be based upon actuals and not an estimate.

**Rate Shock:** Anthem's rate shock (Decision 72047) was a result of the Pulte refund infrastructure business. The Commission had no jurisdiction in rate making as this issue was a civil case. The class action suit against Pulte was the proper course of resolution. Deconsolidation of Anthem's wastewater treatment from Agua Fria's is a rate regulation issue and would result in rate shock. The Anthem Community Council acknowledges this even after proposing a three-year revenue sharing program to mitigate rate shock, per their Initial Post Hearing Brief, dated: January 17, 2012. Quote: "Accordingly, the Commission should not deny deconsolidation simply because there would be some resulting rate shock".

**Cross-subsidization:** During the hearings, we learned there are four (4) systems between Anthem and Agua Fria folks. This makes the separation of Anthem from them complex as any of the remaining systems can also opt to separate which is problematic.

The ROO states that at this time, deconsolidation is not in the public interest until a cost of service is performed for all EPCOR's wastewater systems including Mohave in the NW. I agree.



On Tuesday, April 10, 2012, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) assigned to hear Arizona American Water Company's (EPCOR Water USA) request to deconsolidate the Anthem wastewater district from the Agua Fria wastewater district, issued her Recommended Opinion and Order (ROO) to the Arizona Corporation Commission (Commission).

I was very surprised and disappointed in the ALJ's recommendation to not deconsolidate at this time. That ROO goes beyond the scope of the directive that was included in Decision 72047. That directive, approved by the Commission, specifically addressed deconsolidation of Anthem and Agua Fria. Any study to consolidate all water and/or wastewater districts should not be a consideration in this case. If it is the ALJ's personal desire to have a study for total consolidation, that should be a separate matter for a future date.

There is no reasonable reason for the Commissioners to "kick the can" down the road on this deconsolidation matter. Anthem residents have been and are continuing to pay for wastewater costs of another water district which is not and will not be physically connected to the Anthem Wastewater plant. **That is patently unfair and unreasonable.**

Provided below are reasons why the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) should immediately approve deconsolidation of the Anthem/Aqua Fria Wastewater District:

- (1) The ACC never formally and specifically approved "consolidation" of the two wastewater districts.
- (2) It was a back door "consolidation" resulting from approval of the expansion of several Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CC&N's). Anthem residents never had an opportunity to comment or object to the approval of those CC&N's or the resulting "consolidation."

(3) There is no physical connection between the two districts and none was ever planned, so there is no opportunity for the sharing of resources.

(4) Anthem residents have been paying for the wastewater services provided to customers who do not reside in Anthem.

It is only fair and just for the ACC to approve immediate deconsolidation of the Anthem/Aqua Fria Wastewater District.
