*****TAKES ISSUE WITH ITEM 14 IN MAY 22-23 OPEN MEETING*****

I urge you to oppose the Administrative Law Judge's recommended order in this case and maintain the June 1, 2012 implementation of the winter averaging sewer rate.

Epcor actually made adequate notification, and I took 5 minutes to reduce my drip irrigation timer settings this winter. My average usage was 3000 gallons a month, which is fairly realistic for a two person household. Now that the heat is on Epcor would love to charge me for 7000 gallons of sewer rate rather than the actual 3000 or so that goes ack in waste water. This is just another attempt for 12 months of rate gouge by Epcor, and they know it. By their own rate case numbers they use 5632 gallons as the average customer use, and we all water less in the winter. So you KNOW the average sewer bill is going down by \$15 to \$20 per month. If anything, Epcor is in CONTEMPT for not trying harder, if they think most people missed the opportunity. As them!!!!
