PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 8, 2006, Cordia Communications Corp. ("Company"), filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") its application for a certificate of convenience and necessity to provide resold long distance and facilities-based local exchange telecommunications services in Arizona ("Application").

On March 1, 2006, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Letter of Insufficiency and First Set of Data Requests.

On March 30, 2006, the Company filed its responses to the Data Requests.

On April 20, 2006, Staff filed its Second Set of Data Requests.

On April 28, 2006, the Company filed its responses to the Second Set of Data Requests.

On December 19, 2007, Staff filed its Third Set of Data Requests.

On January 10, 2008, the Company filed its responses to the Third Set of Data Requests.

On April 6, 2009, a Procedural Order was issued requesting Staff to file an update on the status of this docket.

On April 15, 2009, the Company filed its responses to Staff's Fourth Set of Data Requests.

On May 18, 2009, Staff filed a Memorandum stating that Staff was in the process of reviewing the Company's responses to Staff's Data Requests and recommended that the docket remain open.

1 On April 2, 2012, a Procedural Order was filed directing Staff to file a second update on the
2 status of the docket.


3 On May 8, 2012, a letter was filed in the docket advising the Commission that the Company
4 had filed a Chapter 7 Bankruptcy Case in the Middle District of Florida on February 2, 2012. The
5 letter was written by Richard Webber, who had been appointed as Trustee for the Company in the
6 Bankruptcy matter. Mr. Webber stated that Cordia Communications Corp. had ceased all business
7 activities and he requested withdrawal of the Application.

8 On May 18, 2012, Staff filed a Memorandum stating that, based on the information provided
9 by Mr. Weber, Staff does not object to the withdrawal of the Application and recommends that the
10 docket by administratively closed.

11 Staff's recommendation is reasonable and this docket shall be administratively closed.

12 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Docket No. T-02439A-06-0076, In The Matter of the
13 Application of Cordia Communications Corp. for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to
14 Provide Resold Long Distance and Facilities-Based Local Exchange Telecommunications Services in
15 Arizona is hereby administratively closed.


