PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 29, 2011, Pima Utility Company ("Pima" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission applications for rate increases in both its water and wastewater divisions.

On September 30, 2011, a Rate Case Procedural Order was issued consolidating the applications for purposes of hearing, setting a hearing on the consolidated applications, and setting associated procedural deadlines.

Intervention has been granted to the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO").

Numerous public comments have been filed in opposition to the proposed rate increases.

The Commission has scheduled a local public comment session to be held July 10, 2012.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a **public comment session** shall be held in **Chandler, Arizona** on **July 10, 2012**, commencing at **10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as practicable, in the **Sun Lakes County Club, Navajo Room, located at 25601 N. Sun Lakes Blvd, Chandler, Arizona 85248** in order to allow an opportunity for the Company's customers to provide public comment for the record in this case.

11 On August 29, 2011, Pima Utility Company (“Pima” or “Company”) filed with the

Homeowners’ Association forums.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
2 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
3 hearing.
