4.17 AT&T TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SERVICES

4.17.1 Definition

AT&T Telecommunications Relay Services (TRS) are telephone transmission services that provide the ability for an individual who has a hearing or speech disability to engage in communication by wire or radio with a standard telephone user in a manner that is functionally equivalent to the ability of an individual who does not have a hearing or speech disability to communicate using voice communication services by wire or radio. This offering includes services that enable two-way communication between an individual who uses a text telephone ("TTY") or other non-voice terminal device and an individual who does not use such a device, speech-to-speech "STS" services, and non-English relay services.

TRS allows people with hearing or speech disabilities to communicate by telephone with persons who may or may not have such disabilities. This is accomplished through TRS facilities that are equipped with special technology and staffed by communications assistants (CAs) who relay conversations between persons using either text or voice telecommunications devices. To access TRS, a TTY user dials "711" or the toll-free telephone number of the TRS service. For the TTY user, this first step (the inbound call to the TRS center) is functionally equivalent to receiving a "dial tone". The caller then gives the number of the party he or she desires to call to the CA. The CA in turn places an outbound voice call to the called party. The CA serves as the "link" in the conversation, converting all TTY messages from the caller into voice messages, and all voice messages from the called party into typed messages for the TTY user. The process is performed in reverse when a standard voice telephone user initiates the call.

The AT&T Relay Service will accept calls which originate and/or terminate in Arizona, or calls between two other jurisdictions which are billed to a telephone number in Arizona or to a Calling Card (i.e., LEC, Commercial Credit Card or AT&T Calling Card), and which can be dialed directly by a communications assistant at the request of the originating caller.

This plan is an add-on to AT&T's interstate offering and is available where facilities and billing capabilities permit. 4.17 AT&T TELECOMMUNICATIONS RELAY SERVICES

4.17.2 Rates and Charges

AT&T Dial Station calls placed and billed by the Relay provider through the Arizona Relay Service are eligible for the rates specified below and shall be billed to the caller.

For Customers subscribed to an AT&T Optional Calling Plan, with the exception of the AT&T True Reach Plan, Direct Dialed Station and Calling Card TRS calls are billed at the same rate as the Customer's plan.

For Relay Customers who are not subscribed to an AT&T Optional Calling Plan or who are subscribed to the AT&T True Reach Plan, Direct Dialed Station TRS calls are billed as shown in the chart below.

TRS calls placed from a public or semi-public payphone and billed to an AT&T Calling Card, Local Telephone Company Calling Card or Commercial Credit/Charge Card are billed as shown in the chart below, with no per call service charge.

TRS calls (non-payphone calls) billed to an AT&T Calling Card, a Credit/Charge card recognized by AT&T or a Local Telephone Company issued Calling Card are billed at basic AT&T Calling Card rates as found in Section 4.2.3 of this tariff.

Rates and Service Charges for Operator-Handled Calls apply as specified in Section 4.2.3 of this tariff.

There is no monthly recurring charge or usage minimum charge that applies. Customers are also eligible for threshold billing. Customers do not have to be presubscribed to AT&T to be eligible for this offer.
