PROCEDURAL ORDER
GRANTING ADMISSION
PRO HAC VICE

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 7, 2012, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 38(a), Mark A. Nickel, an attorney with Theobald Law, PLC, filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Motion to Associate Counsel Pro Hac Vice for Darin Mangum of Darin H. Mangum, PLLC, in the above-captioned matter ("Motion"), on behalf of Respondents Arizona Gold Processing, LLC, AZGO LLC and Charles L. Robertson. 18 to appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the
19 matter is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to
20 withdraw by the Administrative Law Judge.
