Attached are an original and 13 copies of revised pages to the Comcast Phone of Arizona, LLC, A.C.C. Tariff No. 1, for filing on June 13, 2012.

The purpose of this filing is to implement the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) Second Order on Reconsideration, FCC 12-47, released April 25, 2012.

Background: On November 18, 2011, the FCC released FCC 11-161 and revised its policies and rules governing the billing of Switched Access Service, including the adoption of interstate originating access rates for carriers who exchanged traffic that originated or terminated in IP format. In December of 2011, the Company modified its filed tariffs to implement the FCC's directives set forth in FCC 11-161.

Today's Filing: As noted above, on April 25, 2012, the FCC issued its Second Order on Reconsideration with a proposed effective date of July 13, 2012, the FCC's Second order reconsidered the intercarrier compensation framework for originating traffic that originated or terminated in IP format and modified 47CFR part 51 to state (in part):

"Until June 30, 2014, intrastate originating Access Reciprocal Compensation subject to this subpart exchanged between a local exchange carrier and another telecommunications carrier in Time Division Multiplexing format that originates and/or terminates in IP format shall be subject to a rate equal to the relevant intrastate originating access charges specified by this subpart."

With this filing, the Company revises the originating access provisions of its tariff to conform with the FCC's revised rules set forth in FCC 12-47. A copy of the notice which was sent to Customers is attached. Except as stated above, this filing will not cause withdrawal of service, or conflict with any other schedules or rules.

To Whom It May Concern:

On April 25, 2012, The Federal Communications Commission released a *Second Order on Reconsideration* ("Order") in its Intercarrier Compensation / Universal Service Fund rulemaking that revises the transition plan for originating intrastate access traffic that originates or terminates in IP format ("VoIP-PSTN traffic").¹ The Order has been posted in the Federal Register and is scheduled to go into effect on July 13, 2012. Briefly stated, the Order permits incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers who exchange VoIP-PSTN traffic to impose intrastate access charges on originating intrastate toll traffic.

As a result of the Order, Comcast is making updates to its intrastate switched access tariffs. These updates will re-introduce intrastate switched access elements applicable to originating traffic which were previously in effect on December 28, 2011.

Rate changes specific to Comcast Phone of Arizona are listed as follows;
