Joint Request for an Extension of Time



To Whom It May Concern,

With regard to the aforementioned Docket Number and stated document, Watco, Inc. would like to clarify points that were incorrectly stated by the Arizona Corporation Commission. The Joint Request for an Extension of Time reads, "Staff's site visit was originally scheduled for June 26, 2012. On June 25, 2012, the Company contacted Staff and requested postponement of the site visit until the second or third week in July due to schedule conflicts and personal commitments."

According to a phone conversation on June 20, 2012 with Katrin Stukov of the Arizona Corporation Commission, the site visit was scheduled for Wednesday, June 27, 2012. On Friday, June 22, 2012, Watco, Inc. sent an e-mail to Katrin Stukov requesting the site visit be rescheduled. The wording as contained in the e-mail reads, "With regard to the inspection tentatively scheduled for next Wednesday, June 27, 2012, our work schedule is such that we will not be able to accommodate that time. I would like to reschedule for the first or second week of July."

Watco, Inc. believes that correctly stating the timeframe and wording associated with the request to reschedule the site visit is important and should have been incorporated into the Joint Request for an Extension of Time. I received a message with various questions you posed during a phone conversation. I will attempt to answer the questions according to my understanding of the question. If you have further questions, please e-mail me at watercos@gmail.com.

Please provide the Certificate of Approval to Construct and Certificate of Approval of Construction for Canyon Vista and Cedar Mesa:

Watco, Inc.'s records indicate that the Arizona Corporation Commission has these documents on file in relation to the ACC approved Main Extension Agreement; however, I have attached them here for your convenience.

When was the master meter at Shumway replaced?:

April 3, 2012

Please provide the data loss for Shumway during the last three months:

The data loss for the last three months will not provide the information you are seeking. Since the meter was replaced during the first portion of April, April's data is skewed. May is the following: 42,934 gallons pumped and 41,100 gallons billed. June reports will arrive later this month; I can forward the information if you would like.

Was the new booster pump installed in Silver Lake Estates or Bourdon Ranch Estates?:

The invoice submitted for a new pump is not applicable to Silver Lake Estates or Bourdon Ranch Estates. The invoice specifically lists "Shumway Well", which is located in the Canyon Vista Subdivision. Additionally, the pump installed was a submersible well pump, not a booster pump.

What was the approval date of the Show Low Mountain Ranch main extension agreement?:

The approval date according to the letter received from the ACC, which I presume is in the ACC database, is February 2, 2011.

What size is the storage tank at Show Low Mountain Ranch?

The tank is 400,000 gallons according to the engineer; I believe you should be able to find this information in the approved main extension agreement.

Is the WIFA money obtained to be used for fire hydrants and main line change outs?

No, the WIFA money obtained was not to be used for fire hydrants and main line change outs. The discussion was presented during the finance process that Watco, Inc. would like to add fire hydrants and change out main lines at a future date; however, the amount being discussed was not sufficient to cover

those activities. The WIFA money obtained was for a tie-line between Silver Lake Estates and Bourdon Ranch Estates, meter upgrades and a storage tank.

There was another question relating to additions and deletions that I am unsure of what you are requesting. The data request response contained specific pages separating out Shumway and all pages contained supporting documentation.

With regard to the inspection tentatively scheduled for next Wednesday, June 27, 2012, our work schedule is such that we will not be able to accommodate that time. I would like to reschedule for the first or second week of July. Please let me know what date and time within that time frame works for you.
