EXTENSION OF TIME

14 In Decision No. 71869 (September 1, 2010), issued in this docket, the Arizona Corporation Commission
15 ("Commission") ordered Granite Mountain Water Company ("Granite Mountain") to address its
16 inadequate storage capacity issue by completing one of the following within 18 months after the
17 effective date of the Decision: (1) drill a replacement well to replace existing Well No. 5 (ADWR #55-
18 622083), or (2) construct and install a 110,000-gallon storage tank. The Commission further ordered
19 Granite Mountain, if it chose to address the inadequate storage capacity issue through drilling a
20 replacement well, to file the following with the Commission's Docket Control, as compliance items in
21 this docket, within the following timeframes: (1) within six months after the effective date of the
22 Decision (by March 1, 2011), copies of the Approval to Construct ("ATC") for the replacement well; and
23 (2) within 18 months after the effective date of the Decision (by March 1, 2012), copies of the Approval
24 of Construction ("AOC") for the replacement well.

1 In Decision No. 72294 (May 4th, 2011), issued in this docket, the Commission granted Granite Mountain
2 an extension of time related to the replacement of existing Well #5 or the construction and installation
3 of a 110,000-gallon storage tank until September 1, 2012.

4
5 Granite Mountain had intended to replace the existing Well #5 to comply with the Commission decision
6 and to voluntarily add an additional 50,000-gallon storage tank should the funding be sufficient to allow
7 construction and installation. Granite Mountain has been unable to acquire financing for the project.

8
9 Granite Mountain has several concerns with the plans that had been submitted and approved by the
10 Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") for the new Well #55-220316 as the replacement of
11 the "grand-fathered" Well #55-622083. The new well was to be constructed on the acre lot adjacent to
12 our former office.

13 Those concerns are:

14 1) The only well site we had within 660 feet of the grand-fathered well being replaced was within
15 325 feet of Well #3 55-511771 which is now not consistent in production of the water needed. It
16 is also within 385 feet of Well #4 55-554078 which is our main production well. It would really
17 be ideal if we could move the new well further away from both of the two existing wells (Well
18 #3 & #4). Granite Mountain now has a possible opportunity to acquire just such a location. It will
19 require probably another 30 days to complete the purchase, followed by the application, review
20 and approval by ADWR and ADEQ and subsequent construction to connect the new Well into
21 the existing system.

22 2) Both Well #3 & #4 are located on the acreage where Granite Mountain Stables has been located
23 for 45 years. While the stables are well kept and manure is disposed of away from the premises,
24 there is a possibility that increased nitrogen could percolate into the water table which the
25 company is interested in avoiding.

1 3) Well #3 was deepened a few years ago and was drilled down into the solid granite. The further
2 we can get from the rolling hill behind it the better likelihood of obtaining a good producing
3 well. In the drilling of Well #4, the driller had difficulty with shifting cinders but upon completion
4 Granite Mountain ended up with a good production well. Further distance from that well is
5 desirable. Note from the map attached as Exhibit "A", the locations of Well #3, #4, the grand-
6 father well and the new proposed well #6. The proposed well could hardly be selected in a more
7 appropriate location. It is out more centrally located in the valley and the well has reportedly
8 "strong water", per the well drillers report, shown as Exhibit "B". Drainage from the high slopes,
9 drains through the south end of the new property, we are attempting to obtain within which the
10 well is located.

11 4) Connection from the proposed Well #6 to the main water line on Williamson Valley Road (see
12 Exhibit "A") going to the storage tanks can be made within approximately 420 feet. There is
13 much less chance of diminishing the production at the proposed new well site versus the
14 original location.



16 It should be noted that Granite Mountain does not believe it has a water deficiency at this time and has
17 not had interruption or limitation of water supply to its customers since the original order. Additionally,
18 Granite Mountain supplied adequate water supply for Central Yavapai Fire District during the loss of
19 Granite Mountain's office facilities due to a fire on December 14th, 2011, without interruption to its
20 customers.

22 Paul D. Levie, owner of Granite Mountain Water Co., is in the process of acquiring a property adjacent to
23 Granite Mountain's existing water system. The property is located upon Yavapai County Parcel 102-09-
24 008D. Upon completion of the acquisition, Mr. Levie will sell the existing domestic well (ADWR 55-
25 210719) and grant Public Utility Easements to Granite Mountain. Granite Mountain will petition ADWR
26

1 to convert the existing domestic well to a production well (hereby defined as "Well #6"). Well #6 is
2 within 420 feet of Granite Mountain's water main and represents a significant financial savings to the
3 company as well as the customers serviced by Granite Mountain.



5 Granite Mountain hereby requests an extension of 90 days from September 1, 2012 (December 1, 2012)
6 in order to complete the acquisition, obtain the required approvals from ADWR and Arizona Department
7 of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ").

Dear Well Owner:

Enclosed is a copy of the Notice of Intention (NOI) to Replace a well that you recently filed with this Department pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-596. This is to inform you that the Department has approved the NOI and has mailed or otherwise provided a drilling card authorizing the drilling of the well to the well driller identified in the NOI. The driller may not begin drilling until he has received the drilling card, which must be displayed on the drill rig during drilling.

Well drilling activities must be completed within one year after the date the NOI was filed with the Department. If drilling is not completed within one year, you must file a new NOI before proceeding with further drilling. If in the course of drilling the well, it is determined that the well cannot be successfully completed as initially intended (dry hole, cave in, lost tools, etc.), the well must be properly abandoned and a Well Abandonment Completion Report must be filed as required by A.A.C. R12-15-816(F).

If you change drillers, you must notify the Department of the new driller's identity. Please ensure that the new driller is licensed by the Department to drill the type of well you require. A new driller may not begin drilling until he receives a new drilling card from the Department. If you are drilling a new or replacement well and it is necessary to change the location of the proposed well, you may not proceed with drilling until you file an amended NOI with the Department and the Department issues an amended drilling card to the driller. If county approval was required for the original well site plan (this applies to domestic wells on parcels that are five acres or less), you must submit a new well site plan with the new well location to your local county health authority for approval prior to filing the amended NOI with the Department.

A.R.S. § 45-600 requires the registered well owner to complete and file a Pump Installation Completion Report form (DWR form 55-56) within 30 days after the installation of pumping equipment. A form is enclosed for your use. Also enclosed is a well owner's guide that provides useful information and advice concerning your upcoming well construction project. A.R.S. § 45-600 also requires the driller to file a complete and accurate Well Drillers Report and Well Log (DWR form 55-55) within 30 days after completion of drilling. That form was mailed to your driller with the drilling card. You should insist and ensure that all of the required forms are accurately completed and timely filed with the Department.

Please be advised that A.R.S. § 45-593(C) requires the person to whom a well is registered to notify the Department of a change in ownership of the well and/or information pertaining to the physical characteristics of the well in order to keep this well registration file current and accurate. Any change in well information or a request to change well driller must be filed on a Request to Change Well Information form (DWR form 55-71A) that may be downloaded from the ADWR Internet website at <<http://www.water.az.gov/adwr/content/forms/default.htm#NOI>>.
