Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated ("Mohave" or the "Cooperative")
by and through undersigned counsel provides the following factual information Mohave
deems relevant to the above referenced docket that occurred or became known following
briefing:


- From June 18-22, 2012, Mohave conducted three (3) 2012 District meetings and the 2012 annual meeting, where members elected three Board members for three year terms. Items discussed at each of the meetings included: the reasons for and nature of the rate case, the reasons for and nature of the proposed prepaid service program, the nature and status of advanced metering infrastructure projects, the nature and status of reliability improvement projects, the nature and status of community-based renewable

1 energy projects, and Mohave's efforts to participate in the remarketing of
2 low cost federal power from Hoover Dam.

- 3 • On June 27, 2012, the entire nine member Mohave Board of Directors, its
4 CEO, senior staff and legal counsel met, by telephone,¹ with 3
5 representatives of AARP (including the Arizona Director and Assistant
6 Director) to discuss Mohave's proposed Prepaid Service program, tariff and
7 agreement. Mohave responded to various questions about the specifics of
8 Mohave's proposed prepaid service program. AARP provided no specific
9 suggestions or criticisms of Mohave's specific plan, tariff or agreement
10 during the meeting or thereafter.
- 11 • The over-collected balance of Mohave's PPA was \$532,707.32 as of May
12 31, 2012.
- 13 • July 24, 2012 was the date by which a final decision in this matter was to be
14 rendered pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-103 (which includes an additional 24
15 days due to a Staff requested extension, plus 9 days for the 3 days of
16 hearing).
