





IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF GC PIVOTAL, LLC FOR A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE RESOLID INTRASTATE PRIVATE LINE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN ARIZONA DOCKET NO. T-20787A-11-0095

On February 28, 2011, GC Pivotal, LLC ("GC Pivotal" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resolid intrastate private line telecommunications services within the State of Arizona. GC Pivotal's application also requests a determination that its proposed services are competitive. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has recommended that the Commission approve GC Pivotal's application, subject to certain conditions. The Commission will issue a Decision following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by GC Pivotal, Staff, or any intervenors. If GC Pivotal's application is approved, GC Pivotal will be required to provide services under the rates, charges, terms and conditions established by the Commission. Copies of the application, Staff Report, and any written objections to the Staff Report filed by GC Pivotal will be available during regular business hours at GC Pivotal's office at 200 South Wacker Drive, Suite 1650, Chicago, Illinois 60606; at the Commission's Docket Control Center at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona; and on the internet via the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-Docket function. The Commission will hold a hearing on GC Pivotal's application on August 29, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington, Hearing Room No. 1, Phoenix, Arizona. Oral public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via email (for instructions go to <http://www.azcc.gov/divisions/utilities/forms/publiccommentform.pdf>), or by mailing a letter referencing Docket Number T-20787A-11-0095 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 or 602-542-4251. The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to GC Pivotal or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made, if different from the intervenor;
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105, except

that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before August 16, 2012. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross examine other witnesses. However, it will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. If representation by counsel is required under Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31 and 38, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
