PETITION FOR LEAVE TO
INTERVENE OF SOLARRESERVE,
LLC

IN THE MATTER OF RESOURCE
PLANNING AND PROCUREMENT IN
2011 AND 2012.

Pursuant to A.A.A.C R14-3-105, SolarReserve, LLC ("SolarReserve") hereby moves the Arizona Corporation ("Commission") for leave to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding and, in support thereof, states as follows:

1. SolarReserve is a developer of solar power plants in Arizona, including the Crossroads Solar project which received a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility in Commission Decision No. 72187, the Quartzsite project in western Arizona (recently designated as a Project of National and Regional Significance) and five PV projects.
2. SolarReserve has a substantial interest in this proceeding. The Commission's decision may affect the extent, timing, procurement and source of renewable energy development in Arizona, and SolarReserve could be significantly affected by the Commission's decision.
3. Intervention by SolarReserve will not unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding.


