It has just been brought to my attention that the TEP Energy Efficiency Plan will not be heard at the Commission open meeting on Wednesday (the 19th), and there are no plans to hear any items on Thursday (the 20th). This is very unfortunate and surprising news because it could lead to the unraveling of the entire package to reinstate energy efficiency programs for TEP customers (as the plan is time sensitive and delay into October could upset some of the plan's underlying elements).

As a member of Pima County Interfaith Council and the Tucson Metropolitan Energy Commission, I have been attending all the meeting, hearings and have been reporting to many TEP customers on the progress (or lack of) regarding the Plan. The participation at the evidentiary hearing in Tucson displays the support and need to move these programs forward.

Hello,

I am Robert Nicholas and represent JACO Environmental Inc. one of TEP's selected implementation contractors. JACO specializes in the planning and implementation of refrigerator and freezer recycling/decommissioning programs. I know some of you are familiar with and have been supportive of these programs through the APS and SRP's offerings. I also testified before you in Phoenix in support of approving TEP's revenue recovery and energy efficiency plan back in January of this year.
