PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 21, 2012, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Patrick Leonard Shudak, Promise Land Properties, LLC ("PLP"), and Parker Skylar & Associates, LLC ("PSA") (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the sale of securities in the form of membership interests, investment contracts and/or notes.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On October 22, 2012, a request for hearing in this matter was filed by Respondent Shudak and PSA.

Accordingly, a pre-hearing conference should be scheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a **pre-hearing conference** shall be held on **November 8, 2012, at 2:00 p.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, 2nd Floor Conference Room, Phoenix, Arizona.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized Communications) is in effect and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
2 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission
3 *pro hac vice*.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance
5 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
6 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
7 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
8 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
9 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
11 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
12 ruling at hearing.


