Mr Gill,

Thank you for the quick reply. Tucson Electric Power is my provider here in Tucson.

My concern is that as a snowbird I am in a position to contribute lots of solar power to the TEP in the summer air conditioning season, but if the cutoff date for using energy credits at full rate is in the fall, I cannot use them advantageously against my own electricity bills the rest of the winter. A cutoff date in the spring, on the other hand, would make solar power a sensible investment for me and thousands of others who are not in Tucson in the really hot months.

If your commission is the body that controls the cutoff date for using energy credits from solar power generation, is it possible to have a cutoff date in the spring, either for all or just for some users?

Good Afternoon,

The date for the credit true up for Tucson Electric Power is contained in the utility's annual Renewable Energy Standard Tariff implementation plan. Any change to the true up date would have to be contained in a future REST implementation plan.

The 2013 Implementation plan was filed with The Commission's Docket Control Office on July 12, 2012 and is still a pending matter.
