**PROCEDURAL ORDER**  
**(Schedules Status Conference)**

BY THE COMMISSION:

On September 21, 2012, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Patrick Leonard Shudak, Promise Land Properties, LLC ("PLP"), and Parker Skylar & Associates, LLC ("PSA") (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the sale of securities in the form of membership interests, investment contracts and/or notes.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On October 22, 2012, a request for hearing in this matter was filed by Respondent Shudak and PSA.

On October 24, 2012, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on November 8, 2012.

On November 8, 2012, at the pre-hearing conference, the Division appeared through counsel and counsel appeared on behalf of Respondent Patrick Shudak and also stated that he would now be representing Respondent PLP. Counsel further stated that an issue has arisen with regard to his continued representation of PSA and that the Division is aware of this problem which has not yet

1 been resolved. It was agreed that Answers would be filed on behalf of Respondent Shudak and  
2 Respondent PLP by November 26, 2012, and this filing date was agreed to by the Division. In the  
3 interim, the parties will attempt to resolve the representation issue which involves Respondent PSA.  
4 The parties further agreed that a status conference should be scheduled after the Answers of  
5 Respondent Shudak and PLP are filed.

6 Accordingly, a status conference should be scheduled as agreed.

7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a **status conference** shall be held on **January 10, 2013, at**  
8 **10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 1,  
9 Phoenix, Arizona.


10 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized  
11 Communications) is in effect and shall remain in effect until the Commission's Decision in this  
12 matter is final and non-appealable.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules  
14 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission  
15 *pro hac vice*.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance  
17 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the  
18 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances  
19 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is  
20 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the  
21 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,  
23 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by  
24 ruling at hearing.
