Tucson Electric Power Company's request for a base rate increase of 12.5% is in excess of the current (September 2012) U S inflation rate of 2% and is not justified and should be denied. The ACC should limit approval of a base rate increase for Tucson Electric Power Company to no more than 2%, which would be in line with the current rate of inflation. Senior relying on Social Security payments are not getting an increase of 2% for the year 2013. An increase of 12.5% in the permanent base rate as requested by Tucson Electric Power Company, if approved, will create undue hardship on seniors whose fixed incomes are already stressed by the high costs of food, energy, and medical supplies and services. Therefore, I appeal to the ACC to take into consideration these factors and approve a base rate increase not exceeding 2%.
