

Dear Customer,

On October 1, 2012, SemStream Arizona Propane, L.L.C. ("SemStream") filed a notice of intent/application ("Application") with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") concerning a proposed transaction in which Alliant Gas, L.L.C. will acquire all of the issued and outstanding units of membership interest in SemStream from its current parent company, SemStream, L.P. The Application seeks approval, or alternatively waiver, of the reorganization pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-803.

This Application will have no effect on the rates, terms and conditions for your propane service. Your rates will remain the same, and you will contact the company in the same manner as you do currently. The company personnel will be the same and will continue to provide you the same level of safe and reliable propane service and customer service that you currently receive.

It is anticipated that the Commission will issue a decision regarding the Application following consideration of the matter at a Commission Open Meeting. The Commission's Utilities Division has not yet made a recommendation regarding the Application.

About Intervention

Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. Any petition to intervene should be filed on or before November 30, 2012. If you wish to intervene, you must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send a copy of the motion to SemStream or its counsel, and to all parties of record. Your motion to intervene must contain the following: 1) your name, address, and

telephone number, and the name, address and telephone number of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made, if not yourself; 2) a short statement of your interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of SemStream, a shareholder of SemStream, etc.); and 3) a statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to SemStream or its counsel, and to all parties of record in the case. The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.A.C. R14-3-105. You may obtain contact information for SemStream and other parties from the Commission's website (www.azcc.gov) using E-Docket and Docket No. G-20471A-12-0425, or by contacting SemStream at its Payson or Page offices. Failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the Open Meeting and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comment in the record of the case.
