On April 5, 2012, in Commission Decision No. 73089, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS" or "Company") was ordered to:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, once Arizona Public Service Company has compiled 12 months of data regarding actual energy savings associated with pool pump timers, the Company will file a letter detailing the participation levels for this measure and whether or not the timer measure results in cost-effective energy savings.

In compliance with the requirement above, APS is providing the Commission an update regarding participation levels and cost effectiveness for the Demand Side Management ("DSM") Pool Timer measure which was approved as part of APS's Residential Consumer Products program.

After the issuance of Commission Decision No. 73089 was decided, the only company which manufactured the "seasonally adjusted" Pool Timers¹ approved as part of APS's Consumer Products program went out of business. This has left the market without a widely distributed product that meets the current APS program guidelines, and consequently program participation was extremely low.² Therefore, sufficient participation data was not available to conduct research regarding the cost effectiveness of the measure.

Because there are currently no opportunities for customers to purchase qualifying timers, APS has not included pool timers as an eligible measure in its 2013 Implementation Plan filing. If a new product becomes available which meets APS's

¹ It should be noted that APS's pool timer measure is a separate from APS's variable speed pool pump measure which is currently approved as part of APS Consumer Products program.


