

Re: Wastewater and Reclaimed Water Services

Please accept this letter as a request from the ownership of the Copperleaf development for sewer and reclaimed water service to approximately 1207 acres, more particularly described in Exhibit A attached hereto. Even though current market conditions may delay development activity, it is our intention to continue to pursue the rezoning, preliminary platting, and ultimate development of this master planned community located within both the 208 permitted areas and the Certificated of Convenience and Necessity area for Hassayampa Utility Company.

As you are aware, Maricopa County required regional solutions for water and wastewater and reclaimed water as part of the Development Master Plan and Zoning processes. In order to help create those regional solutions for water and wastewater, we have made substantial investments in advance of utilities for this property, not the least of which was entering into an agreement with and making a \$3,750,000 payment to Global Water, the parent Company of Hassayampa Utility Company. \$1,875,000 of the original \$3,750,000 along with funds from other developers, was utilized by Global to acquire Water Utility of Greater Tonopah and the balance of \$1,875,000 which was already paid, in addition to future contributions of \$16,875,000 which will be made to Global Water in incremental payments, are intended to pay finance charges on regional sewer, reclaimed water and water infrastructure financed by Global and constructed by HUC and WUGT to service our property and the entire area west of the Hassayampa River.

Since we have a contract and have made such a substantial investment and committed millions of dollars to the parent company of HUC, we have no choice but to request service from Hassayampa Utility Company.
