FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Copper Valley Telephone, Inc. (Copper Valley) is certified to provide telephone service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.

2. On July 24, 1998, Copper Valley filed tariff revisions to introduce advanced Custom Calling Services, or, as they are commonly referred to, Custom Local Area Signaling Service (CLASS) features:

- Section 1, Sheet Nos. 1-2, 1st Revised
- Section 1, Sheet Nos. 3-4, 1st Original
- Section 9, Sheet Nos. 1-4, 1st Revised
- Section 9, Sheet Nos. 5-17, Original
- Section 21, Sheet No. 1, Original

1           3.       CLASS features are optional services that are intended to provide a called party  
2 with greater information concerning incoming calls and more options for responding to those  
3 incoming calls. The proposal introduces new calling features such as, Caller Identification  
4 (Caller ID), Anonymous Call Rejection (aka Block the Blocker), Automatic Call Back (aka  
5 Continuous Redial), Automatic Call Return (aka Last Call Return), expanded offerings for Call  
6 Forwarding (including Call Forwarding Busy Line and Call Forwarding No Answer) and  
7 Distinctive Ringing (aka Teen Service).

8           4.       Copper Valley serves approximately 4,600 customers located in four (4)  
9 exchanges in southeastern Arizona. Copper Valley plans to deploy the proposed new services in  
10 all its exchanges; however, approximately one percent of Copper Valley's customers will not be  
11 able to subscribe to the Caller ID service initially because carrier systems that currently provide  
12 dial tone to their lines are not compatible with the service. Copper Valley plans to replace these  
13 carrier systems by year end at which time all of Copper Valley's customers will be able to  
14 subscribe to the Caller ID service. The proposed residential rates for the new services range  
15 from a high of \$5.50 per month for Caller ID-Name and Number to a low of \$1.25 per month for  
16 Call Forwarding Busy Line. The proposed business rates for these same services are \$7.50 per  
17 month and \$2.50 per month, respectively. Customers would be able to subscribe to these  
18 features individually or they can subscribe to feature packages that offer two or more features at  
19 discounted rates.

20           5.       Per Call Blocking would be provided at no charge. Line Blocking would also be  
21 provided at no charge the first time it is ordered. Customers changing locations and/or telephone  
22 numbers would also be able to order line blocking once at no charge, as would new customers.  
23 Customers ordering, cancelling, and then reordering Line Blocking, without changing location or  
24 telephone number would be assessed a non-recurring charge of \$8.00 for residences and \$10.00  
25 for businesses. Line Blocking would be provided at no charge under any circumstances to Law  
26 Enforcement and Domestic Violence Agencies.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall become effective immediately.


