I need to continue using my analog meter because of chronic neurological symptoms that can be incapacitating, and are made worse by exposure to certain seemingly "low" levels of radiofrequency and electromagnetic fields.

However, it is critical that any APS customer who wants to continue using their analog meter be permitted to do so.

I am extremely concerned about the smart grid being vulnerable to foreign attack, atmospheric conditions, and domestic hacking, and resulting privacy and security issues.
