**TUCSON ELECTRIC POWER
COMPANY'S REQUEST FOR AN
ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC**

On January 31, 2013, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 73637 ("Decision") in the above-captioned matter. Upon review of the Decision, TEP found that the Decision does not reflect the new Monthly Customer Class Caps resulting from the budget reductions adopted by the Commission. Accordingly, TEP requests that the Decision be amended as follows:

1. Page 26, Finding of Fact No. 65: Add the following sentence after the table:
"However, due to the budget reductions discussed and approved herein, the Monthly Class Caps (based on a REST surcharge of \$0.008000 per kWh) shall be set as follows:

<i>Residential</i>	\$3.80
<i>Small Commercial</i>	\$130
<i>Large Commercial</i>	\$1,050
<i>Industrial and Mining</i>	\$7,700
<i>Public Authority</i>	\$170
<i>Lighting</i>	\$130"

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2. Page 32, line 2: Insert "as modified" after "Staff budget option".
