On February 7, 2013, the Administrative Law Judge issued a Rate Case Procedural Order in the above-captioned matter. UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNS Electric", "UNSE" or "Company") moves for a revised procedural schedule. The revisions are intended to include a settlement track, while further attempting to avoid conflict with another rate case that commences on July 15, 2013.

UNS Electric requests that the following schedule be adopted in this docket:

- Staff/Intervenor Direct Testimony (except rate design) Friday, June 28, 2013¹
- Staff/Intervenor Direct Testimony (rate design) Friday, July 12, 2013
- Settlement Discussions Commence Monday, July 22, 2013
- Settlement Agreement filed Monday, August 12, 2013
- UNSE Rebuttal (if no settlement) Monday, August 12, 2013
- Settlement Direct Testimony in Support/Opposition Monday, August 26, 2013
- Settlement Response Testimony in Support/Opposition Monday, September 9, 2013
- Staff/Intervenor Surrebuttal (if no settlement) Friday, September 13, 2013



5 UNS Electric believes that a settlement track can provide benefit by potential conserving
6 both Commission and Company resources. Two recent rate cases have resulted in settlement
7 agreements using the settlement track approach. The proposed schedule above incorporates a
8 settlement track (similar to the settlement track that was adopted for the pending Tucson Electric
9 Power rate case in Docket No. E-01933A-12-0291), while retaining the same pre-hearing
10 conference and hearing dates as set forth in the February 7, 2013 Rate Case Procedural Order.

11 UNS Electric has discussed this matter with Staff and RUCO and has been authorized to
12 represent on their behalf that Staff does not oppose the revised schedule, and that RUCO is in
13 agreement with the revised schedule.

14 Wherefore, UNS Electric respectfully requests that a procedural order be issued adopting
15 the revised schedule.
