

**WAL-MART STORES, INC.'S  
APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO  
INTERVENE**

Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. and Sam's West Inc. (collectively "Walmart"), pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-105, hereby petitions the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an order allowing Walmart to intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support of its motion, Walmart states as follows:

1. In its Open Meeting on January 23, 2013, the Commission directed the Hearing Division to conduct a hearing on several matters concerning Arizona Public Service Company's ("APS") application for approval of its 2013 Renewable Energy Standard Implementation plan, including the treatment of renewable energy credits.

2. Walmart is a retailer having 56 facilities in APS's service territory, including discount stores, Supercenters, Sam's Clubs, distribution centers, and gas stations.

3. Walmart has established a goal to be supplied by 100% renewable energy,

1 and has renewable energy facilities sited at a number of its facilities in APS's service  
2 territory.

3 4. Walmart will be directly and substantially affected by the treatment of  
4 renewable energy credits from renewable generation projects located at its facilities.

5 5. The granting of intervenor status to Walmart will not delay this proceeding  
6 or cause the issues to be unduly broadened, nor will it unduly prejudice APS or any other  
7 interested parties.

25 that the presiding Administrative Law Judge issue an order granting this motion.


