As the Administrative Services Manager of Casa Grande Elementary School District #4, I write to express our support for net metering, the straightforward electricity bill credit arrangement that allows Arizona schools and universities to save money on their energy bills. This simple and fair policy is saving Casa Grande Elementary School District #4 money on our electricity bills, allowing constrained financial resources to be directed to other, more critical, educational activities.

Casa Grande Elementary School District #4 invested in three solar energy systems, totaling 1,951,000 kilowatts, with a clear understanding of the associated energy bill savings stemming from the projects. We urge the Commission not to authorize any rollbacks of net metering for customers such as our school that have already invested in solar energy systems.

We urge you as our elected energy Commissioners to protect our investments and ensure that the utilities are required to adequately account for the benefits net metered solar energy provides to all electricity customers. We ask you to continue to support our ability to invest in local clean energy by protecting net metering.
