RE: Complaint from Dianah Ness concerning Klaudia Ness

Judge Stern and Commission Staff,

I am responding regarding the complaint docketed by Dianah Ness dated in February, 2013. I am questioning the validity of Mrs. Ness' complaint and the concerns she is addressing. It is apparent that she has no clue that the annual report is available online, which reflects that her husband Erik Ness is the President of Bellefont Water Company. Also in referring to my daily duties, she claims I refuse to give minutes. There are never any meetings to take minutes; at least not any meetings that I was aware of or invited to and, as a side note, I have never refused their calls because they never call me. That, in itself, should be a complaint of mine, since I was excluded from many meetings and does effect me as a current board member and shareholder. In regards to the bank statements, I arranged for Wells Fargo to send Erik Ness statements every month. It became an expense and hardship, and felt that this way, he would receive the statements in a timely manner each month. The bank can verify that this is being done. In her complaint, she did include a copy of a bank statement to which she claims they were not receiving. There is an interesting variety of people living at the Ness address. It would be easily determined that no one knows who receives the mail at any given time. I received a certified stub with an uncle's signature. So in fact, her claim that she does in fact receive the mail and put in the same spot is not a true statement. The standpipe money has had to be utilized due to the drop in metered customers, high water testing, breaking down of equipment, and obtaining a new accountant to help fix the mess the Rodney Wilson created. Essentially, the company is in a bankrupt status due to the misappropriation of funds from the Ness family. Thankfully, I was able to save and use the funds for much needed repairs. I do make several trips to Bellefont each week. I am doing my due diligence to make sure that the company is being taken care of. My car doesn't get good gas mileage, and Bellefont is a 40 mile round trip that

is sometimes made twice a day. I feel that Dianah Ness' letter is no more than a letter from someone who knows that they didn't know how to operate this company, and has little knowledge of it at all, which is why we are in litigation. Currently, she is not a concerned stock holder as she claims. The Ness family has surrendered their interest in the company.

Lastly, my concerns with Rodney Wilson. He has not done his due diligence in regards to filing the appropriate tax forms for the company. Sadly, he is trying to obtain money that is in the standpipe account to collect a debt from the previous owners that he forgave upon the Ness' purchase of the company, in September 2006, that was owed by the McClains, the previous owners of Bellemont Water Company. This debt is over 7 years old!! He kept charging the company for miscellaneous charges that were rarely itemized on his invoices, only to find out, he hasn't filed anything in 4 years!! He is no longer the accountant for Bellemont Water Company. I have retained Carol McDaniels from Platinum Business Strategies to get the company back in good standing.

I enjoy working for Bellemont Water Company. I know how this company operates and am asking the staff to recommend that I stay employed with the company to ensure that the company is operating correctly. Thank you for your consideration.
