PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 31, 2012, UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNSE" or "Company") filed the above-captioned rate application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission").

By Procedural Order issued February 7, 2013, as modified by Procedural Order issued February 11, 2013, this matter was scheduled for hearing and various filing deadlines were established.

On February 15, 2013, Nucor Corporation ("Nucor") filed a Petition to Intervene. To date, no objections to Nucor's intervention request have been received.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that **Nucor Corporation is hereby granted intervention.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Arizona Supreme Court Rules 31, 38, and 42 and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to the practice of law and admission *pro hac vice*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
2 Communications) applies to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the Commission's
3 Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
5 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
6 hearing.
