Dear Mr. Berry:

Thank you for expressing your concerns about the Far West rate case pending before the Arizona Corporation Commission. You can track the case's activity and progress by visiting the Commission's e-Docket website, <http://edocket.azcc.gov/edocket>, and entering the docket number: WS-03478A-12-0307.

The commissioners have not yet made a decision regarding Far West's request for a rate increase. The case is currently being heard before an administrative law judge and that judge will issue a recommended order and opinion ("ROO"). Once the ROO is issued, the matter will be set for open meeting. The commissioners will not make their final decisions regarding the rate increase request until that open meeting which is the designated time for the parties to discuss the ROO. Open meeting is also the time when the commissioners can ask the parties questions about the case. The parties to the case include the Residential Utility Customer Office, an organization that represents the ratepayers' interests, as well as the utility and other stakeholders.

Commissioner Burns values public input and comments concerning matters that come before the Commission for a decision. However, his final decision will not be made until the open meeting. Any information to the contrary is incorrect.
