

Dear Chairman and Commissioners:

I am writing to you regarding the installation of wireless digital meters aka AMI (Advanced Metering Infrastructure) or AMR (Automated Remote Reader) on personal property of APS customers throughout the state of Arizona of which I am adamantly opposed.

This is an invasion of personal property and an unsolicited change of meter for measuring and billing purposes of electricity. I do NOT give permission to APS to change/install a wireless digital meter on my property. It is a violation of the 4<sup>th</sup> amendment to the United States Constitution, where we are guaranteed the right to be secure in our persons and houses. This is a monitoring and surveillance meter, which even the phone company cannot listen to conversations without a warrant/court order. I am asking you to issue a STOP ORDER on the installation of these digital meters. If an individual wants one, let them request one. Mandatory replacement of analog meters without consent is a violation of privacy and personal property invasion. The safety and effectiveness of these meters has not been proven...if anything, they have proven to be unsafe and unreliable. The majority of people have spoken, and we DON'T want them

As you were campaigning, you promised to be the people's advocate for fair rate charges and oversight of these huge corporations to protect the consumer against unfair and unreasonable usurpation of rights by the various utility companies in this state.
