STIPULATION BETWEEN ALECA AND BOOMERANG WIRELESS, LLC

Boomerang Wireless, LLC ("Boomerang") and the Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association ("ALECA") submit the following stipulation concerning Boomerang's Application in this docket:

1. Boomerang is seeking ETC designation on certain lands of Federally Recognized Tribes in Arizona.
2. To address potential ALECA concerns with this requested designation, Boomerang agrees that it will not provide Lifeline service to eligible residents residing on the lands of Federally Recognized Tribes in Arizona until Boomerang has obtained any and all necessary licenses or other forms of approval that may be required by a Tribe. Before providing such service on tribal lands, Boomerang will file a copy of the tribal license or other form of approval with the Arizona Corporation Commission in Docket No. T-20861A-12-0415, with a copy to ALECA's undersigned counsel.
3. To ensure that Boomerang does not inadvertently provide service to residents of the lands of a Federally Recognized Tribe for which Boomerang has not obtained all

necessary licenses or other forms of approval, Boomerang further agrees that its Lifeline enrollment application for Arizona will:

- (a) Require an applicant to provide a street address; and
- (b) Include a provision that requires an applicant under penalty of perjury (i) to self-certify that he or she does not reside on Federally Recognized Tribal Lands in Arizona, or (ii) to identify the Federally Recognized Tribe on the lands of which he or she resides.

If the applicant does reside on the lands of a Federally Recognized Tribe for which Boomerang has not received the approvals identified in Paragraph 2, Boomerang will not provide service to the applicant.

- 4. Given this stipulation, ALECA does not oppose Boomerang's Application in this docket and does not believe that a hearing is necessary to address ALECA's concerns.


