PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 31, 2013, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision Nos. 73636 for Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”), 73637 for Tucson Electric Power Company (“TEP”), and 73638 for UNS Electric, Inc. (“UNS”) in the above-captioned dockets (“2013 REST dockets”).¹ Those Decisions directed that the Commission would consider the proposed

1 “Track and Record” mechanism (as well as alternatives thereto), for APS, TEP and UNS
2 (collectively, “Utilities”) at a hearing.

3 Procedural Orders have been issued setting a hearing on the Track and Record issue, ordering
4 public notice of the hearing and setting associated procedural deadlines.

5 The parties to this proceeding currently include APS, TEP, UNS, the Commission’s Utilities
6 Division (“Staff”), Freeport-McMoRan Copper & Gold, Inc. (“Freeport-McMoRan”), Arizonans for
7 Electric Choice and Competition (“AECC”), Solar Energy Industries Association (“SEIA”), Western
8 Resource Advocates (“WRA”), the Vote Solar Initiative (“Vote Solar”), Arizona Solar Energy
9 Industries Association (“AriSEIA”), Sonoran Solar, LLC (“Sonoran”), Wal-Mart Stores, Inc. and
10 Sam’s West Inc. (collectively “Walmart”), the United States Department of Defense and all other
11 Federal Executive Agencies (“DoD”), Interwest Energy Alliance (“Interwest”), Kevin Koch, and the
12 Residential Utility Consumer Office (“RUCO”).

13 On May 9, 2013, at its Staff Open Meeting, the Commission indicated that a procedural
14 conference should be held in this matter prior to the next RUCO workshop planned in these dockets.

15 On May 14, 2013, the Commission’s Legal Division filed a Request for Procedural
16 Conference (“Request”). The Request states that a RUCO proposed workshop on net metering is
17 scheduled to be held on May 29, 2013, and that the procedural conference directed by the
18 Commission is intended to provide interested parties an opportunity to comment on the appropriate
19 processes related to that workshop. The Request asks that a Procedural Order be issued setting the
20 procedural conference, and suggests that the procedural conference be held on either May 20 or May
21 21, 2013.

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
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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a procedural conference shall commence on **May 21, 2013, at 1:30 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practicable, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room No. 1, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, for the purpose of affording interested parties an opportunity to provide comment on the appropriate processes related to RUCO's proposed workshop on net metering scheduled for May 29, 2013, and on any other procedural issues related to these dockets.
