

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On April 19, 2013, Arizona Public Service ("APS") filed its Request to Extend Deadline to File 2014 Demand Side Management Implementation Plan ("Request").
2. Pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R14-2-2405(A), the deadline for APS to file its 2014 Demand Side Management ("DSM") Implementation Plan is June 1, 2013.
3. The Request asks that the Commission extend the deadline for APS to file its 2014 DSM Implementation Plan to 45 days following the issuance of a Commission Decision on APS's 2013 DSM Implementation Plan (Docket No. E-01345A-12-0224).
4. APS states that there are still a number of open issues surrounding its 2013 DSM Implementation Plan, including, among others, a performance incentive structure for 2014, an expansion of the ability to count energy savings, the ability of certain large commercial customers to opt-out, and the methodology used to determine the cost-effectiveness of programs and measures.

1 APS states that many of the open issues it describes may be resolved when the Commission takes up
2 APS's 2013 DSM Implementation Plan, and that their resolution will impact assumptions underlying
3 APS's 2014 DSM Implementation Plan. APS states that because of the open issues, good cause
4 exists under A.A.C. R14-2-2419 to extend the filing deadline.

5 5. On May 20, 2013, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Memorandum
6 in this docket stating that Staff has no objection to the Request.

7 6. The Request is reasonable and should be granted.

8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

9 1. APS is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona
10 Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-250, 40-251, 40-301, 40-302, and 40-303.

11 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over APS and the subject matter of this proceeding.

12 3. Good cause exists to grant APS's request for a time extension, pursuant to A.A.C.
13 R14-2-2419, to extend the deadline for APS to file its 2014 DSM Implementation Plan, until 45 days
14 after the Commission issues a Decision on APS's 2013 DSM Implementation Plan.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the compliance deadline for Arizona Public Service Company to file its 2014 DSM Implementation Plan is hereby extended to 45 days after the issuance of a Commission Decision on Arizona Public Service Company's 2013 DSM Implementation Plan in Docket No. E-01345A-12-0224.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
