RE: ARIZONA PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY – REQUEST TO EXTEND DEADLINE TO FILE 2014 RENEWABLE ENERGY STANDARD IMPLEMENTATION PLAN (DOCKET NO. E-01345A-13-0140)

Arizona electric utilities that are subject to the Arizona Renewable Energy Standard and Tariff (“REST”) Rules, Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-1801, et seq. are required to file annual REST Implementation Plans by the first of July. The deadline for filing the 2014 REST Implementation Plans is July 1, 2013.

On May 17, 2013, Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”) filed a request for an extension of time to file its 2014 Renewable Energy Standard Implementation Plan from July 1, 2013 until July 14, 2013, pursuant to waiver provisions of A.A.C. R14-2-1816(B).

APS mentions in its filing that Decision No. 73636 (January 31, 2013) ordered APS to conduct a multi-session technical conference to evaluate the costs and benefits of distributed renewable energy and net metering (“DE Technical Conference”). APS’ request for a filing extension will allow APS to fully evaluate the results and findings of the DE Technical Conference.

Staff has reviewed the APS extension request and finds that there is good cause for the extension. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the Commission grant a two-week extension as requested by APS, moving the filing due date from July 1, 2013 to July 15, 2013 (July 14th is a Sunday).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”) is certificated to provide electric service as a public service corporation in the state of Arizona.
2. Arizona electric utilities that are subject to the Arizona Renewable Energy Standard and Tariff (“REST”) Rules, Arizona Administrative Code (“A.A.C.”) R14-2-1801, et seq. are required to file annual REST Implementation Plans by the first of July. The deadline for filing the 2014 REST Implementation Plans is July 1, 2013.
3. On May 17, 2013, Arizona Public Service Company (“APS”) filed a request for an extension of time to file its 2014 Renewable Energy Standard Implementation Plan from July 1, 2013 until July 14, 2013, pursuant to waiver provisions of A.A.C. R14-2-1816(B).

3 5. Staff has reviewed the APS extension request and finds that there is good cause for
4 the extension. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the Commission grant a two-week extension
5 as requested by APS, moving the filing due date from July 1, 2013 to July 15, 2013.

6 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7 1. Arizona Public Service Company is an Arizona public service corporation within
8 the meaning of Article XV, Section 2, of the Arizona Constitution.

9 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Arizona Public Service Company and over
10 the subject matter of the application.

11 3. The Commission, having reviewed the application and Staff's Memorandum dated
12 May 28, 2013, concludes that it is in the public interest to approve a two-week extension to file the
13 2014 REST Implementation Plan to July 15, 2013.

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ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Arizona Public Service Company's deadline to file its 2014 Renewable Energy Standard and Tariff Implementation Plan shall be July 15, 2013.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
