

PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 5, 2012, Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPSCO") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a rate decrease.

On September 11, 2012, a Rate Case Procedural Order was issued setting a hearing and associated procedural schedule for the processing of the application.

On March 5, 2013, a Procedural Order was issued revising certain filing deadlines in this proceeding, as requested by the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff").

Intervention has been granted to Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Trico") and Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC").

On May 23, 2013, Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated ("Mohave") filed a Motion to Intervene. Mohave requests that it be granted intervention past the intervention deadline specified in the Rate Case Procedural Order. Mohave states that its participation will not unduly broaden the issues to be presented because Mohave adopts the position of AEPSCO, and that Mohave's participation is necessary and appropriate. Counsel for Mohave avers that it has discussed its intervention in this matter with all parties, and no party opposes Mohave's intervention.

On May 24, 2013, AEPSCO filed a Motion to Extend Rebuttal Testimony Due Date. AEPSCO requests that the due date for it to file its rebuttal testimony be extended to June 13, 2013. Counsel for AEPSCO states that following communication with counsel for Staff and other parties concerning

1 its request, Staff is in agreement with the extension of time and AEPCO received no objections from
2 the other parties.

3 Accordingly, Mohave should be granted intervention and AEPCO should be granted the
4 requested extension of time to file its rebuttal testimony.

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Mohave Electric Cooperative, Incorporated is hereby
6 granted intervention.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. is hereby granted
8 an extension of time, to **June 13, 2013**, to file its rebuttal testimony.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
10 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
11 hearing.
