BY THE COMMISSION:

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. KPV Enterprises, LLC ("Applicant") has a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide customer-owned pay telephone ("COPT") service in Arizona pursuant to Decision No. 68342 (December 9, 2005).
2. On February 12, 2013, the Applicant filed with the Commission an application for cancellation of its Certificate ("Application").
3. On March 15, 2013, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed its Staff Report.
4. In the Application, the Applicant indicated it no longer provides, or never did provide, COPT services in Arizona and requested cancellation of its Certificate without a hearing.
5. Staff stated in its Staff Report that the Consumer Services Section of the Utilities Division reported that there are no consumer complaints, inquiries, or opinions filed against the Applicant. The Compliance Section of the Utilities Division indicated that the Applicant does not

1 have any outstanding compliance issues with the Commission.

2 6. Staff recommended approval of the Application and cancellation of the Applicant's
3 Certificate.

4 7. Staff's recommendation is reasonable and shall be adopted.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 1. The Applicant is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
7 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

8 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Applicant and the subject matter of the
9 Application.

10 3. The cancellation of the Applicant's Certificate is in the public interest.

11 4. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue Decisions regarding COPT
12 Certificates without a hearing.

13 5. Staff's recommendation is reasonable and should be adopted.




