**REQUEST TO EXTEND DEADLINE TO
FILE 2014 RENEWABLE ENERGY
STANDARD IMPLEMENTATION
PLAN**

15 Arizona Public Service Company requests an extension of time to file its 2014
16 Renewable Energy Standard Implementation Plan from July 1, 2013 until July 15,
17 2013.¹ APS still intends to file its 2014 RES Implementation Plan as close to July 1 as
18 possible, but may need the additional time to fully consider other potential inputs as
19 described below.


20 In Decision No. 73636 (January 31, 2013), the Commission ordered APS to
21 conduct a multi-session technical conference to evaluate the costs and benefits of
22 Distributed Renewable Energy and Net Metering ("DE Technical Conference"). At the
23 conclusion of the DE Technical Conference, APS will finish its evaluation of the
24 information presented at the Technical Conference and ultimately file a proposal with
25 the Commission addressing the costs and benefits of DE and Net Metering.

26 APS requests an extension of time to file its 2014 RES Implementation Plan so
27 that APS has an opportunity to fully evaluate whether and how the DE Technical

1 Conference findings inform APS's 2014 RES Implementation Plan. APS believes that
2 the need to evaluate the DE Technical Conference findings constitutes good cause for an
3 extension, particularly since APS only seeks an additional two weeks to file its 2014
4 RES Implementation Plan and can discern no prejudice to any interested party.
5 Accordingly, APS requests that the Commission extend the deadline for APS to file its
6 2014 RES Implementation Plan by 14 days from July 1, 2013 to July 15, 2013.
