

At a time when the future of the coalfired plants near the Grand Canyon is in doubt due to EPA regulations and the costs associated with either bringing the plants into compliance or closing them completely, rooftop solar is of a benefit to the entire state.

I know that due to my extreme measures to limit the need for cooling during the summer I am a net generator of power during peak time-of-use periods during summer months. Basically, I limit the air conditioner to run only if I have used less than 1.5 kWh in an hour. Otherwise the system will not run until the next hour. Because I have spent money on a tight home and a 17 SEER, two compressor, air conditioner I cool the house to 72 degrees using off-peak power and then let the temperature drift upwards until 8:00 PM, at which time the house gradually returns to 72 degrees and thermal banks coolness for the next day.




