I am a solar collector owner as well as a thirty year supporter of the concept. I am asking you to protect net-metering. When I built my home in Payson I was told by APS that net-metering would be available and so I added geothermal heating and cooling to my plans. The solar collectors power the geothermal ground heat pumps. With this combination I have no combustion in the home and give off NO greenhouse gases whatsoever.

This is something that you must seriously consider. Net-metering makes this all possible and I would not have considered it if Net-metering was not available. People like us are allowing APS to provide power to its customers without having to build more polluting power plants. We need to be justly compensated for our efforts to provide a cleaner environment.
