It was a new, networking meter. The bed where I had been lying was on the second floor directly above the meter placement. That night I rigged up a sleeping bag by the breakfast nook on the farthest corner of the house and got some rest. This experience increased my passion to urge study of health impacts of wireless meters. I concur with those calling for a moratorium where possible and generous opt-outs as a retro action where needed, as in my case. I am appreciative.





Meter Placement
