



I wish to opt out of having a Smart Meter installed on my property. I not only have concerns about health safety, but I also have concerns about privacy in regards to the Smart Meter. Further, I want any and all fees (\$75 set up and \$30/month) waived as per the City of Sedona Council meeting decision of June 19, 2013.

APS presenters made their case, Sedona Smart Meter Awareness made their case, and the public forum made their case. Afterward, the City of Sedona made the decision to opt out without fees.

Even if I felt the meters were safe – I do not feel the meters are safe – there is no foreseeable cost benefit. Why should you waste your (our money) or extort our money charging us Opt Out fees? After the APS presentation, Councilman Martinez asked about “bottom line” cost benefits. Your APS rep answer was 1) costs are approved by the commission, 2) monthly meter reading fee is \$1.90 and *should go down*, and 3) whenever they realize a savings, the customer will get a savings.
