COMPLAINANTS' QUARTERLY
STATUS UPDATE

16 Complainants Roger and Darlene Chantel are hereby filing
17 the following quarterly status update to the Commission
18 regarding the status of Complainants' Superior Court action
19 against Respondent Mohave Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Superior
20 Court of Arizona in and for Mohave County, Case No. CV2009-
21 02574) and (Arizona Appellate Court, Division One, Case No. CA-
22 CV 12-0411).

23 This quarterly update is being filed by Complainant Roger
24 Chantel. The Defendant/Appellee filed a Writ of General
25 Execution in the Mohave County Superior Court on February 21,
26 2013. The Plaintiffs/Appellants filed a Motion to Quash Writ of
27 General Execution in the Mohave County Superior Court on March
28 15, 2013.

29 The Plaintiffs, Dustin R. Chantel, a disabled veteran of
30 the United States of America, and Elizabeth Chantel file the
31 following Quarterly Report. A complaint was filed in local and
32 state jurisdiction. The complaint issues are: Trespassing,
taking Plaintiffs' property without just compensation, clouding

1 the property title, failure to pay rents on property Defendants
2 are still using, failure to bring electric line and poles up to
3 code, malicious use of power by disconnecting Plaintiffs'
4 electricity when a medical need existed, refusing to perform on
5 a contract, disregard for State Mandated Laws. Some new
6 allegations on the Defendant is communicating with judges to
7 attain a verdict that the issues of the case had no merit and
8 the court did not have to make decisions on evidence that was
9 presented to the court.

10 The Plaintiffs reserve their rights of liberty and justice
11 as citizens and as a veteran of a county that fights for justice
12 and freedoms for individuals. The Plaintiffs exert their rights
13 to appeal these issues to a "Citizens' Court" for determination
14 by fellow citizens or peers who have continuous electricity
15 delivered to their homes. The Plaintiffs are exercising their
16 right to create a "Citizens' Trial" by their peers.

17 As the times and dates become available, this jurisdiction
18 will be invited to address and defend any laws within their
19 jurisdiction.
