I am writing as a resident of Sun City who has invested in solar, and want to share my concerns regarding net metering. APS is proposing to change the current net metering policy. This means that solar energy credits will no longer be tied to the retail rate of electricity, and solar customers will not receive fair compensation for the energy their systems produce.

APS' actions prove that they are trying to limit energy choice and limit the adoption of the most popular form of energy in the state of Arizona. We need to stand up against the utility monopoly.

I feel that APS wants to change the rules after so many of us on fixed incomes invested in solar power to save money. I believe that solar energy is important, not only because it saves money, which is critical for retirees on fixed incomes, but also as a benefit to our community as a whole.


Dear Vance,
